INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES (INTERNAL EXAMINATION / TEST)

1. Students should pay their **greatest effort** on revising and preparing before the examination. Extra-curricular activities will be suspended **two weeks** before the examination until the end of the examination of all secondary levels.
2. Students should turn off their mobile phones before entering the school.
3. There will be no morning assemblies during the examination period. Students should proceed to the examination rooms **15 minutes** before the examination starts.
(Note: Students are advised to proceed to the hall or classrooms on the 3/F and 4/F through the front staircase while the rest should use the rear staircase or the new annex staircase.)
4. Students should enter the examination rooms only with the permission of invigilators. They should **keep quiet** and take their seats as planned.
5. Students should keep absolute silent throughout the examination, and should follow all the instructions given by the invigilator, otherwise they will be liable to severe punishment and/or receive a mark penalty.
6. Students are only allowed to put their calculators approved by HKEAA/subject teachers, stationery and watches on the desk. Other belongings (such as wallets, books, bags, notes, pencil boxes, sheets of paper and exercise books, etc.) should be put under the chairs.
7. Students should be absolutely honest. Students found cheating in the examination will be liable to severe punishment and **score '0' mark on the subject paper**.
8. Students who are late may be permitted to sit for the examination but without any compensation.
9. Students who are sick should inform the general office before 8:30 a.m., and submit their sick leave applications countersigned by their parent / guardian together with a medical certificate, to the general office on the day of return. There will be no supplementary examinations for absentees.
10. **For oral examination**, students must report to the reporting room supervisor at the **reporting time**. Students who are late will receive a mark penalty. If students arrived the reporting room after the examination session starts, he / she **CANNOT** sit for the oral examination, and will **score '0' mark on the subject paper**. There will be no supplementary examinations for absentees.
11. For senior levels listening papers, candidates not bringing a radio, earphones, or batteries will receive a mark penalty.
12. Students absent from examination with approved medical identification or acceptable reason(s) will be assessed basing on their past daily performance. An estimated mark will then be given.
13. Students are not allowed to borrow any stationery during the examination.
14. When the examination is over, students should not leave any belongings in the examination room. They should keep quiet and proceed to the ground floor. No games of any types are allowed.
15. Under special circumstances such as tropical cyclones or heavy persistent rain, etc., the Education Bureau may make announcement of the closure of all schools. The examination on that day will be postponed. Students will resume the normal examination as previously scheduled when returning to school. The rearrangement of the affected examination sessions will be arranged on the following Saturday or will be announced on the school website.
