I. SCHOOL INFORMATION

A. School Profile

Christian Alliance Cheng Wing Gee College was established in 1984, the third school affiliated with the Kowloon Tong Church of the Chinese Christian and Missionary Alliance. Our school is a full-time aided co-educational secondary grammar school.

B. Mission Statement

Based on Christian ethos, the unified team of devoted, collaborative staff members of the school advocates whole-person and balanced education in the areas of spirituality, ethics, intellect, physique, social skills and aesthetics. It is hoped that the students can develop self-confidence, self-discipline and self-learning spirit in a supportive and encouraging environment. At the same time, we aim to help our students learn the redemption gospel, understand life-guiding principles, learn to be well-mannered, think discreetly and show discernment, act swiftly and be healthy, know how to appreciate others and artistry, love their families and community, contribute to the country, and ultimately glorify God and benefit mankind.

C. School Motto

“The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.” (Proverbs 9:10)

D. Campus Facilities

The school improvement programme of the new block completed in 2004 provides extra space to improve the learning environment and students’ multi-intelligence development. There are 30 standard classrooms and special rooms equipped with IT teaching and learning facilities. The library, provided with online databases, enables students to learn and access information outside classrooms according to their needs and interests.

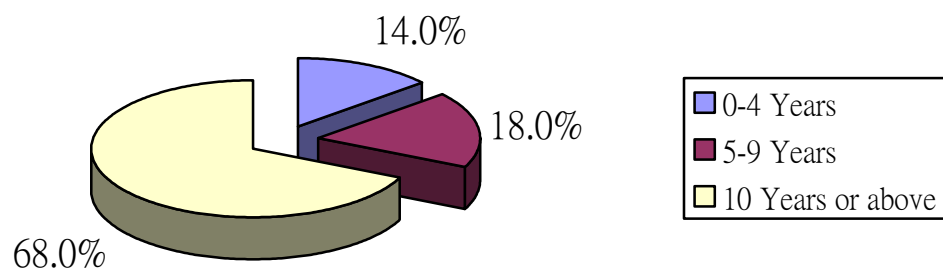

I. Teaching Staff's Qualifications & Professional Development

Our teaching staff members, including holders of one PhD, 32 master and 62 bachelor degrees, are well-qualified and experienced. Moreover, all of our English and Putonghua teachers have either been granted exemption from or have fulfilled the Language Proficiency Requirement.

Our teachers were encouraged to acquire subject knowledge and prepare well for their teaching. In the academic year 2017-18, our teachers enrolled various in house and off-campus training courses with a total of 5300 hours (to the nearest 100). Some teachers also enhanced their professional training by pursuing master degrees in their subject areas.

II. ACHIEVEMENTS & REFLECTION ON MAJOR CONCERNS OPERATIONAL STRATEGIES

Major Concern 1: To enhance the learning and teaching effectiveness

Achievements:	
1.1	Both students (79%) and teachers (93%) opined that the homework assigned to students could match their abilities. It was applicable to all levels of students from junior to senior levels. It was also reflected by subject teachers that students' submission of their homework was in general having improvement.
1.2	Over 90% of teachers said that their subjects implemented pre-lesson preparation work while about 75% of students said that pre-lesson preparation work was arranged by teachers. It indicated that pre-lesson preparation had become one of the routines in learning and teaching.
1.3	Over 90% of teachers reflected that students followed closely their instructions and engaged in the learning tasks during the lessons whereas over 80 % of students claimed that they followed closely the instructions of teachers and over 70% of students agreed that they participated in the learning tasks in the lessons. These figures showed that learning and teaching was conducted smoothly in class with reasonably good student participation.
1.4	Over 80% of teachers said that their lessons were of good discipline while about 80% of students also said that they had good classroom discipline.
Reflection:	
1.1	Pre-lesson preparation has been done by most students in all subjects in 2017-18 and hence it is necessary to encourage our students to have more in-depth exploration of the subject contents both during and after the lessons for better consolidation and mastery of the knowledge so as to become more self-directed learners.
1.2	About 90% of teachers reviewed that they could meet the requirements set in the school-based professional development policy. The acquisition of skills of using e-Learning tools can be the focus of teachers' training in the coming school years. Hence, the more self-regulated learning strategies can be adopted by students if more 'IT in Education' is implemented in learning and teaching.
1.3	Peer observation should be further encouraged among teachers of the same panel or across different subject panels for enhancement of their teaching strategies and widening of horizons. Besides, more professional interflow sessions can be arranged in panel meetings while more time and space should be created for teachers to have professional development in the making-up of school calendar for 2018-19.
1.4	The "Yes I CAN" learning award scheme was better received by students in 2017-18 and it can be kept in the coming school year to help students of the junior levels to have more expectations both in their academic work and participation in various areas so as to have whole-person and all-round development. Yet, it is also found that having encouragement by class teachers is of paramount importance. Thus, having great support of class teachers will lead to success of this scheme.

Major Concern 2: To build up students to be responsible with self-discipline and self-management

Achievements:	
2.1.	Regarding students' respectful attitude to oneself and others, about 80% of teachers found that student-teacher relationship was improved. There were teachers voluntarily willing to help supervise S.1 students to do homework and revision for 45 minutes (3:50- 4:35 pm) after school every school day in 2017-18. Teachers' concern and extra support given to students would lead to closer ties between students and teachers. Besides, the work of counseling and personal contact with students by teachers did increase the bondage and understanding among teachers and students.
2.2	About 70% of teachers also found that students showed improvement in their courtesy manners.
2.3	About 75 % of teachers agreed that students' sense of self-discipline and sense of responsibility were found improving, which were reflected in their submission of homework.
2.4	Over 75% of teachers opined that the communication between the school and students was improved.
Reflection:	
2.1	Students were found being more responsible in their submission of homework especially among S.1 students who stayed behind after school in classrooms with teachers' assistance to build up learning habit every school day. Some students continued to stay in classrooms and do their homework after 4:35 pm as they were eager to finish doing their homework before going home. They learn to be a responsible student. It will be desirable if this learning habit building exercise can be extended to S.2 as well in 2018-19.
2.2.	The building up of students' character, self discipline and sense of responsibility, etc should be the concerted efforts of different committees, clubs and societies. It is also our belief that the Christian faith, assemblies and BK classes, gospel week, religious services and so on help students to develop good attributes and behaviour.
2.3	Students were conscious of their conduct and behaviour. Thus, they should be encouraged to have higher expectations towards themselves while teachers can keep giving them clear instructions and more encouraging remarks.
2.4	If students are assigned more duties in school not necessarily confined in their academic work, they can learn to be more responsible and at the same time they can develop their leadership skills.

III. OUR LEARNING & TEACHING

A. Reading to Learn

The arrangement of book sharing of senior-level students for junior-level students and the collaboration with the school library in promoting reading helped cultivate an extensive reading atmosphere among students. Both junior-level and senior-level students could benefit from this exercise. Reading activities are arranged by subject teachers and committee heads, students are expected to read books and articles of various subject contents so as to widen their scope and read the materials which match with the mass events held in school. We also aim to promote 'Reading across the Curriculum' by making effective use of a variety of texts including non-fiction texts on various themes and topics. It is hoped that students can be engaged in reading and also be able to connect their learning experiences, broaden their knowledge base and enhance their language skills. Yet, more collaboration between teachers of different KLAs and language teachers is needed in future. Book exhibition also helps in providing more incentives and resources for students. To facilitate teachers and students to read, resources spent on online databases and e-books are increased gradually every year.

B. Project Work

Cross-curricular projects were implemented at our junior secondary levels, from S.1 to S.3. Students got involved in one or two projects every year. There was collaboration among different subject panels.

S.1: Computer Literacy, Mathematics and Visual Arts

S.2: Integrated Science, Computer Literacy and Chinese History

S.2: History and Visual Arts

S.3: Geography, Design & Technology and Mathematics

C. Information Technology for Interactive Learning

The school is well-equipped with information technology facilities. All classrooms and special rooms are equipped with a computer, projector and visualizer. The Campus TV provides students with opportunities to enhance their creativity, problem-solving ability and communication skills. Its facilities were upgraded in 2015-16 and the years onwards.

It is hoped that more students' potential can be stretched. E-Class has been adopted for both school administration and interactive learning. Students submit their assignments and get comments from teachers through the e-Class. There is also further exploration of the online learning platform – Google Classrooms & Google Suites for Education. Discussion and communication are encouraged among students and teachers by using this platform. Besides, 'Kahoot' and 'Plickers' are used to enhance teaching and learning in classroom. An e-Learning coordinator is assigned in each subject to explore and implement different e-Learning pedagogies and resources at subject level. In addition, sharing sessions on e-Learning tools or practices are arranged during general staff meetings by members of the Information Technology Committee to promote staff professional interflow, which helps to enhance teaching and learning among teachers. The library is well-equipped with information technology facilities and students can use different online databases for self-learning as they can make access to the school library website any time at home.

D. Implementation of Diversified Curriculum and Learning Activities

It is our aim to enable every student 'to become an informed and responsible citizen with a sense of national and global identity, appreciation of positive values and attitudes as well as Chinese culture and respect for pluralism in society.' The values like 'Showing Perseverance', 'Having Respect for Others, Sense of Responsibility, National Identity, Commitment, Integrity and Caring for Others' are expected to be found in the teaching and learning of all Key Learning Areas. A working group has been set up to be concerned about the promotion of Basic Law Education in school. The Convenor, who is the Chairperson of the Chinese History Panel, will work with his members including the Chairperson of the Moral and Civic Education Committee and Vice- Chairperson of the Liberal Studies Panel. It is hoped that students can hence have better understanding of the importance of Basic Law and the principle of 'One Country, Two Systems'.

E. Learning without Boundaries

Other Learning Experiences Day was arranged for all students to experience learning outside the classroom. A wide variety of activities including visit, adventure-based learning activity, music appreciation, career-related programme, community service and

different careers talks were organized. In 2017-18 subject-based study tours were arranged for students, e.g. study tour to Taichung by the Chinese Panel for the appreciation of culture and lifestyle of people in Taiwan (5 days in June & July 2018); study tour to Xian by the Chinese History Panel for the study of the historical sites & monuments of this traditional Chinese capital city (5 days in June & July 2018). There were also visits and exchange activities with our sister school, Guangzhou Yuyan Middle School ‘廣州市玉岩中學’ (3 days by the end of March 2018); a visit to the Chang Jung Christian University ‘長榮大學’ in Tainan by the Careers and Outreaching Committee as an experiential programme for students to have better understanding of having further studies in Taiwan (4 days in July 2018). There was also a visit to Zhaoqing for environmental study of the district by the Moral and Civic Education Committee (2 days in June 2018).

IV. SUPPORT FOR STUDENT DEVELOPMENT

Our school bears the mission of nurturing students’ whole-person development and personal growth as individuals and members of the community through collaboratively organizing programmes by the School External Affairs Committee, Religious Affairs Committee, Moral and Civic Education Committee, Discipline Committee, Counselling Committee and Extra-curricular Activities Committee with Christian faith as our mission and vision .

A. Pastoral Care

We believe that every student is unique and deserves individual care. Our students are provided with a strong network of support through a dual class teacher system; orientation programmes for S.1 and S.4 students; Big-Brother-and-Big-Sister Scheme; teacher training and workshops on catering for students with special educational needs (SEN). Ever since 2010, we have held two to three weeks of S.1 Orientation Programmes for S.1 students to help them adapt to their new school life by concerted efforts of different committees. In 2017-18, an S1 Orientation Camp (3 days & 1 night) was organized for students. It was hoped that students could better prepare themselves for their secondary education. Besides, the great support given by the educational psychologist (about 20 visits a year with collaboration and support given to teachers and

parents by the school sponsoring body, funded by the EDB), the school social worker (by Hong Kong Children and Youth Services, funded by the EDB), a part-time counselling worker and an additional full-time teacher (funded by the Learning Support Grant) met the needs of SEN students and at the same time provided pastoral care for those students who were in need. In a word, our school team members endeavour to realize our potential and develop a deepening sense of care for the needy students and their family.

B. Inclusive Education

Student Support Team for SEN (SST) has been formed since 2008 to cater for students with special educational needs. Each year identification work starts with S.1 registration in which parents are invited on a voluntary basis to submit information regarding their children with special educational needs. Follow-up work is then provided for both newcomers as well as existing SEN students. Through Special Education Management Information System (SEMIS), the school applies for the Learning Support Grant (LSG) for Secondary School. The LSG is used for providing SEN students with appropriate supportive measures and services.

Various supportive strategies and measures have been adopted for SEN students, with a referral system set up for all teaching staff for any suspected cases which will then be referred to the educational psychologist for consultation and /or assessment. Apart from referrals, various school-based supportive measures, which included regularly having contacts with students' parents, arranging education programmes or accommodation for each SEN student, were adopted and there were also case conferences for teachers. Teachers are also advised to adjust the classroom management techniques, teaching strategies, assignments given to the students concerned in order to cater for individual needs. Other support such as speech therapy training for individual students, study groups and social skills groups have been provided for students with the corresponding needs as well.

C. Character building via spiritual, moral and civic development

For students' character building, Christian value is instilled in students by offering Life Education lessons, Biblical Knowledge lessons, fellowship programmes, services and religious activities throughout the year as well as Gospel Week held in late October every

year. Christian students and teachers give their personal witness and share their faith via hymn singing sessions while sharing sessions are also regularly arranged in the morning assemblies. About 100 students attend the fellowship programmes during lunch hour on Tuesdays while about 50 students join the worship and group activities on Sundays in KTAC, Tai Wai. Praise the Lord and thanks should go to both parish workers and teachers who make the very good church-school collaboration possible between the church and school.

To foster students' positive moral value and civic awareness, the promotion of environmental protection and use fewer bottles are advocated. Along with the various school-based teaching kits on moral issues, it is hoped that students' sense of civic awareness can be developed. Besides, the inter-class competitions on cleaning, discipline and bulletin board design also help to foster our students a sense of responsibility, to develop their class spirit and sense of ownership in school.

D. Students' potential and leadership development

In recognizing students' potential, various ambassador award schemes were devised. The 'Student All-round Award Scheme' encouraged students to have wholesome and balanced development. While the 'Student of the Class Scheme' recognized students' perseverance, courtesy and caring spirit apart from their very good performance in learning. The various 'Outstanding Student Awards' aimed at having students' potential recognized and their achievements honoured. Besides, the 'Students' Perseverance Award Scheme' and 'Outstanding Leadership Award Scheme', which were initiated and supported by the Alumni Association in 2017-18, encouraged students to work with perseverance and develop their potential in various respects. For S.6 students, there were the awards of 'Student of the Year' and 'Outstanding Service Award', with the former granted to S.6 student who had both outstanding performance in academic work and services provided to school or the community whereas the latter granted to the student who had reasonably good academic results and provided outstanding services to school or the community. It is our hope that students can stretch their potential and develop their leadership to become leaders of tomorrow with the provision of different awards for students of various levels.

E. Career development

To facilitate individual students to make their own planning, various introductory exercises of the world of work were provided for students as well as activities that could promote self-understanding of their personalities, skills, academic interests and career aspirations. Further exploration of students' interest in work was arranged with the aids of Basic Interest Marker Test (BIM) and Career Interest Inventory Test (CII). Students were guided in interpreting assessment outcomes, supported in formulating their career goals and educational planning as well as developing career management skills that prepare them as life-long learners in society. Career counselling interviews were arranged for S.1- S.3 students whereas guided tours, discipline-specific career talks, workplace tours, subject-specific taster programmes or faculty visits were arranged for S.3-5 students. Admission talks and preparation courses were arranged for S.5-6 students. There were also parent talks on multiple pathway arranged for parents of S.5 & 6 students in 2017-18.

The 5th Career Kaleidoscope @ CWGC was successfully held on 2nd May 2018. There was CareerExpress@CWGC 2017 having 12 career workshops collaborated with Edvenue for S.1-3 students, who could then widen their scope and horizons. On the same day, there was CareerSharing @CWGC 2017 having 21 parallel sessions on various careers with the collaboration of Hong Kong Professionals and Senior Executives Association (HKPASEA) and Alumni Association of our school for S.4-5 students. Students gained invaluable opportunity to learn directly from prominent figures in various professions who shared their success stories and insights in life.

Over 20 S.3-5 students participated in the JA Company Programme in 2017-18. They got seven awards and it was delighted that our team won the Champion, 'Company of the Year', among over 70 participating local and international schools in Hong Kong. All these awards justified members' tenacious effort and their gratifying pleasure, which were worth being commemorated. It is anticipated that the participants can pass on the torch of knowledge in launching enterprises to the JA members in subsequent years.

F. Community and global outreaching

Through participating in 'iCare 8' Voluntary Service Campaign and Other Learning Experiences activities arranged by the Moral and Civic Education Committee and the Extra Curricular Activities Committee, students were given opportunities to take part in numerous community services and experiential voluntary activities such as visiting the elderly home; serving the homeless, physically impaired and low-income groups. Their readiness to help and pleasing serving attitude reflected that our students did show their care and concern for the needy in the community. To extend our students' global horizons, five trips were organized by our teachers including trips to Taichung, Xian, Guangzhou, Tainan and Zhaoqing in March, June and July 2018. All these excursions have brought students home with enriching exposure and insights.

G. Home-School and Alumni Co-operation

A group of dedicated volunteers and committee members of the Parent-Teacher Association Committee (PTAC) have been assisting school in various school and off-campus activities. They offered assistance in organizing seminars, interest groups and running sharing sessions for parents. They also made donations to the students and their family who had financial needs, and presented awards to the students who did well in their attendance and handing in assignments. Their contributions did bring a closer tie between the school and family, thus building up students' sense of belonging to school. Besides, the Alumni Association gave their support to school in many ways. Some alumni shared with students their study skills and strategies to prepare for public examinations while many others reserved their time and assisted in the school careers talks, 'Career Kaleidoscope @ CWGC' via sharing and conducting workshops to help boost students' career aspirations.

V. STUDENT PERFORMANCE

A. HKDSE Examination Results

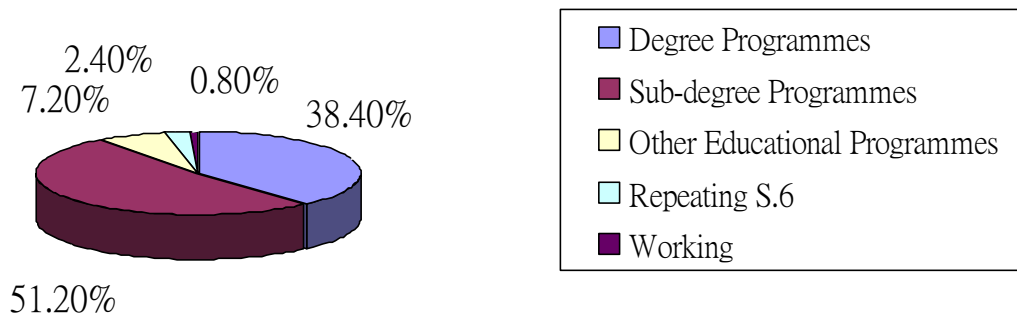
Among individual subjects, the percentages of having level 5** in Mathematics, Biology and Chemistry are better than those in Hong Kong candidates. 33% or more of students attained level 4 or above in 11 subjects out of 15 subjects offered by the school, in which Mathematics Extended Module (M2) got 84.6%, Visual Arts got 66.7% and Chemistry got 53.3%. Besides 99.2%, 92%, 95% and 96% of our students got level 2 or above in

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English Language, Chinese Language, Mathematics (Core part) and Liberal Studies respectively.

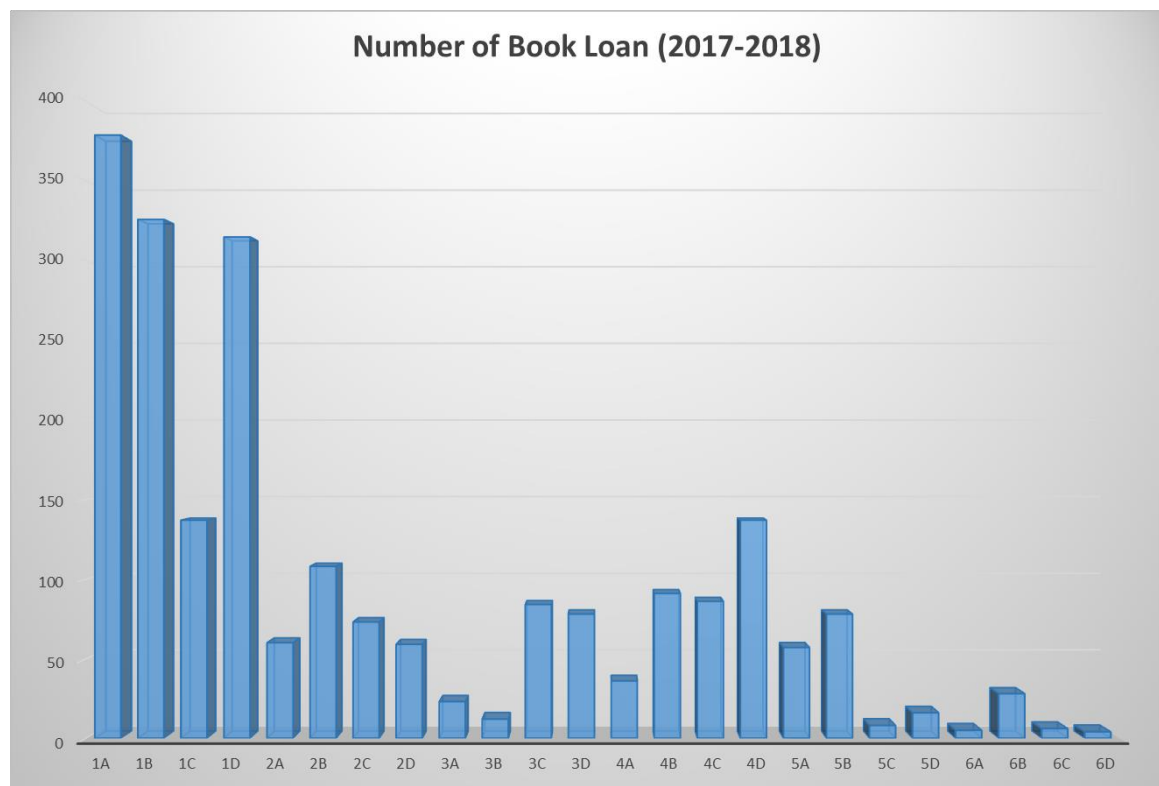

The evaluation of Domain 2 (Learning and Teaching) and Domain 3 & 4 (Student Support & School Ethos and Student Performance) were made during the Third and Fourth General Staff Meeting held on 24th November 2017 and 26th January 2018 respectively. Findings of APASO as well as Stakeholders’ Survey for teachers, students and parents were made used of in our evaluation. 2015-18 School Development Plan and 2017-18 Annual School Plan were evaluated on School Self Evaluation Day on 23rd March 2018 whereas suggestions for 2018-21 School Development Plan and 2018-19 Annual School Plan were made and discussed during the Fifth General Staff Meeting on 20th April 2018 while teachers discussed the plans for their respective subjects and committees during the School Development Planning Meeting Day on 11th May 2018.

Having made evaluation by different stakeholders at various levels, 2018-21 School Development Plan and 2018-19 Annual School Plan were discussed and finalized during the Sixth General Staff Meeting held on 25th May 2018.

After considering the achievements and reflections made for the School Development Cycle 2015-18, the needs and performance of students in 2017-18 as well as the school's future development, the following concerns will be highlighted for the coming School Development Cycle 2018-21 and Annual School Plan 2018-19:

- Major Concern 1: To nurture students with the essence of being self-directed learners;
- Major Concern 2: To empower students to shoulder responsibilities and stretch their potential; and
- Major Concern 3: To empower the middle management team for school future sustainable development.

Having considered students' performance inside and outside of classrooms as well as teachers' opinions in the past school year, we aim at assisting students to develop good working habits and learn to become more self-directed learners; shoulder more responsibilities, unleash their potential and develop their leadership. Besides, we hope that there will be continuous staff professional development with focus on middle management team, which will be empowered for school future sustainable development.
