#### I. SCHOOL INFORMATION

#### A. School Profile

Christian Alliance Cheng Wing Gee College was established in 1984, the third school affiliated with the Kowloon Tong Church of the Chinese Christian and Missionary Alliance. Our school is a full-time aided co-educational secondary grammar school.

#### **B.** Mission Statement

Based on Christian ethos, the unified team of devoted, collaborative staff members of the school advocates whole-person and balanced education in the areas of spirituality, ethics, intellect, physique, social skills and aesthetics. It is hoped that the students can develop self-confidence, self-discipline and self-learning spirit in a supportive and encouraging environment. At the same time, we aim to help our students learn the redemption gospel, understand life-guiding principles, learn to be well-mannered, think discreetly and show discernment, act swiftly and be healthy, know how to appreciate others and artistry, love their families and community, contribute to the country, and ultimately glorify God and benefit mankind.

#### C. School Motto

"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding." (Proverbs 9:10)

#### D. Campus Facilities

The school improvement programme of the new block completed in 2004 provides extra space to improve the learning environment and students' multi-intelligence development. There are 30 standard classrooms and special rooms equipped with IT teaching and learning facilities. The library, provided with online databases, enables students to learn and access information outside classrooms accourding to their needs and interests.



#### I. Teaching Staff's Qualifications & Professional Development

Our teaching staff members, including holders of one PhD, 30 master and 29 bachelor degrees, are well-qualified and experienced. Moreover, all of our English and Putonghua teachers have either been granted exemption from or have fulfilled the Language Proficiency Requirement.

Our teachers were encouraged to acquire subject knowledge and prepare well for their teaching. In the academic year 2020-21, our teachers enrolled various in house and off-campus training courses with a total of 3800 hours (to the nearest 100). Some teachers also enhanced their professional training by pursuing master degrees in their subject areas.

### II. ACHIEVEMENTS & REFLECTION ON MAJOR CONCERNS

### **OPERATIONAL STRATEGIES**

Major Concern I: To nurture students with the essence of being self-directed learners

#### **Achievements:**

- 1.1. Over 90% of teachers agreed that students could be nurtured with the essence of being self-directed learners via (i) Building up students' intrinsic motivation in learning, (ii) Expanding students' learning capabilities and (iii) Enhancing teachers' teaching professionalism.
- 1.2 For Target 1, generally over 85% of teachers and 70% of students agreed that the implementation of various strategies to enhance the learning initiative of students having different abilities, the mastery of learning for students having different abilities and collaboration among students in different subjects could fulfil the success criteria set. The most impressive figure in student survey was the agreement percentage (87.49%) that they often accomplish assigned tasks/assignments of the subject. Last but not the least, it was found that 100% of teachers agreed that they had implemented strategies to enhance the learning initiative of students having different abilities.
- 1.3 For Target 2, about 90% of teachers agreed that the students' learning capabilities had been expanded by implementing E-learning during lessons, widening students' reading scope, enhancing students' reading skills and implementing pre-lesson preparation. During the period of pandemic, students had to use electronic media to learn and over 80% of students agreed that they were capable in this area. The most impressive figures were the agreement percentages in the success of implementing pre-lesson preparation which were over 90% and 85% in general among teachers and students respectively.
- 1.4 For Target 3, over 85% of teachers agreed that the professional development programmes conducted by the school could enhance their teaching professionalism. About 90% of teaches had conducted peer observations and over 85% of them agreed that peer observation offered them interflow on (i) Students' initiative in learning, (ii) Students' mastery of learning, (iii) Students' collaboration and (iv) Students' e-learning skills.

#### **Reflection:**

- 1.1 For Target 1, only 60% of teachers agreed that students had built up their intrinsic motivation in learning despite of the high percentages of agreement found in the various strategies implemented. The school is advised to have more consideration in future towards the suitability and effectiveness of strategies devised for achieving the targets set.
- 1.2 There is still room for improvement in building up the learning confidence of students. It is advised to furnish more learning exposure and experiences of achievement inside and outside school for students.
- 1.3 The issues of reading participation among students has to be addressed as similar feedback was received form parents, teachers and students. More creative ideas like using IT platform in reading promotion are needed to arouse students' interest.

**Major Concern II:** To empower students to shoulder responsibilities and explore their potential

#### **Achievements:**

- 2.1. Both junior-level students and senior-level students who had served as committee members of clubs or societies or student service groups opined that they had enhanced their expression and presentation skills while having on-stage presentation. A very high of percentage of 94.29% was got from junior-level students. Besides, 85.96% of senior-level student-leaders reflected that their self-confidence was increased while being given opportunities to address the mass and speak on-stage. All levels of students enjoyed shouldering more responsibilities through which they felt good, their skills being sharpened and confidence increased.
- 2.2 Though the school days were cut short in 2020-21 because of the pandemic, both senior-level and junior-level students were satisfied with the collaboration among committee members. It was especially true for junior-level student-leaders as 94.46% of them thought that they could acquire leadership skills while working with their senior counterparts, 97.06% of feeling satisfied with the collaboration and also 97.06% of feeling very happy about the teamwork achieved. Regarding senior-level student leaders, above 90% of them found the collaborative work in their groups satisfying.
- 2.3 100% of class teachers opined that students could learn about the importance of teamwork and responsibility via various programmes, mass events and life education lessons, etc.
- Over 90% of students reflected that they could learn about how to build up one's power of leadership from the talk delivered by alumni.

#### **Reflection:**

- Yet, it was delighted to know that there was good collaboration among student leaders no matter whether they were junior-level or senior-level students. The Peer Mentoring Scheme is a good initiative and a 'mentoring culture' and supporting spirit among students have been promoted, which should be continued in future.
- 2.2. All the excursions could not be held as scheduled because of the pandemic. It is hoped that those activities that have been cancelled can be arranged in future. Yet, it is not easy to make plans of arranging overseas trips as we have difficulties in figuring out when our lives will no longer be adversely affected by COVID-19
- About 70% of ECA or Student Service Group advisors reflected that more meetings could be arranged for student-leaders in their respective committees. Teacher advisers may need more time and space so that student-leaders can have more interactions among themselves and, at the same time get more guidance from teachers for advice and improvements.

## Major Concern III: To empower the middle management team for school future sustainable development

#### **Achievements:**

- 3.1. School suspension due to the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic, the actual implementation was severely disrupted. The middle management staff members reflected that they were empowered as they could be involved in school policy-making.
- The middle management staff members found their leadership and management skills had been enhanced, though not many professional development programmes could be arranged as scheduled.
- 3.3 The middle management staff members agreed that the objectives have partially achieved.

#### **Reflection:**

- It is suggested that a "whole-school approach" should be introduced so that teachers can have a better understanding of the operation of the school. A strategic planning in stretching teachers 'potential by inviting more teachers to take up deputy posts, so that teachers can participate in more school administrative duties and a continual work-tiered force will be formed.
- 3.2 To enhance teachers' capacity and integrate Christian faith among staff, the essence of "Unity, Courageous and Christ-centered" should be introduced and reinforced by organizing various training programs, such as, good practices sharing among different subject panels and administrative departments, team building activity, school visit, internal and external staff professional development programs.
- To enhance learning and teaching effectiveness, peer lesson observation and open-classroom sharing sessions should be reinforced so as to create a school culture of loving to share and cooperate.

#### III. OUR LEARNING & TEACHING

#### A. Reading to Learn

The arrangement of book sharing of senior-level students for junior-level students and the collaboration with the school library in promoting reading helped cultivate an extensive reading atmosphere among students. Both junior-level and senior-level students could benefit from this exercise. Yet, the number of sharing sessions has been greatly reduced because of the prolonged school suspension in the second term. Reading activities are arranged by subject teachers and committee heads, students are expected to read books and articles of various subject contents so as to widen their scope and read the materials which match with the mass events held in school as well. We also aim to promote 'Reading across the Curriculum' by making use of a variety of texts including non-fiction texts on various themes and topics. There is also School Reading Award like the activity of 'Let Reading Shine' to encourage students to enjoy reading. It is hoped that students can be engaged in reading and also be able to connect their learning experiences, broaden their knowledge base and enhance their language skills. The views collected in the stakeholders' survey showed that students' motivation to read should be noted and more strategies have to be adopted to promote reading among students. To facilitate students to read and make use of the resources like online databases and e-books in the library, students will be required to make use of the above facilities to do their assignments as what we did in the past years but more incentives will be given to students.

#### **B.** Project Learning

Despite of the school suspension due to the pandemic in 2020-21, cross-curricular projects at junior levels as stated below were launched aiming at providing students learning experiences to integrate and apply knowledge and skills across disciplines.

Chinese History

S.1: Integrated Science + Computer Literacy + Design & Technology

S.2: Integrated Science + Computer Literacy + Design & Technology + Chinese History

#### C. Information Technology for Interactive Learning and Self-directed Learning

The school is well-equipped with information technology facilities. All classrooms and special rooms are equipped with a computer, projector and visualizer. The Campus TV provides students with opportunities to enhance their creativity, problem-solving ability and communication skills. Its facilities were upgraded in 2015-16 and the years onwards. It is hoped that students' potential can be more fully stretched by participating in the activities organized. E-Class and Google Classroom has been adopted for both school administration and interactive learning. Students submit their assignments and get comments from teachers through the Google Classroom. Discussion and communication are encouraged among students and teachers by using email and various online platforms. An e-Learning coordinator is assigned in each subject to explore and implement different e-Learning pedagogies and resources at subject level. In addition, sharing sessions on e-Learning tools or practices have been arranged during general staff meetings by Chairperson of the Information Technology Committee (ITC) to promote staff professional interflow, which helps to enhance teaching and learning among teachers. During the period of school suspension, online learning and teaching became the daily routine. Thanks should go to the efforts made by teachers and colleagues of ITC. Online lessons were conducted and online learning tools like Kahoot!, EdPuzzle and Nearpod were frequently used by teachers.

#### D. Value Education including Basic Law Education + Safeguard National Law

It is our aim to enable every student 'to become an informed and responsible citizen with a sense of national and global identity, appreciation of positive values and attitudes as well as Chinese culture and respect for pluralism in society.' The values like 'Showing Perseverance', 'Having Respect for Others, Sense of Responsibility, National Identity, Commitment, Integrity and Caring for Others' are expected to be found in the teaching and learning of all Key Learning Areas. A working group has been set up to be concerned about the promotion of Basic Law Education in school. The Convenor, who is the Chairperson of the Chinese History Panel, will work with his members including the Chairperson of the Moral and Civic Education Committee and Vice- Chairperson of the Liberal Studies Panel. It is hoped that students can hence have better understanding of the importance of Basic Law and the principle of 'One Country, Two Systems'.

Also, the school has formed a working group on safeguarding national security and national security education to adopt a whole school approach in formulating and implementing the related measures as well as to strengthen students' virtue cultivation and to promote communication and collaboration among different stakeholders.

### E. Learning without Boundaries

Various activities as stated below were held/participated in to offer students learning experiences outside the classrooms despite of the limitations due to the pandemic in

#### IV. SUPPORT FOR STUDENT DEVELOPMENT

Our school bears the mission of nurturing students' whole-person development and personal growth as individuals and members of the community through collaboratively organizing programmes by the School External Affairs Committee, Religious Affairs Committee, Moral and Civic Education Committee, Discipline Committee, Counselling Committee and Extra-curricular Activities Committee with Christian faith as our mission and vision.

#### A. Pastoral Care

We believe that every student is unique and deserves individual care. Our students are provided with a strong network of support through a dual class teacher system; orientation programmes for S.1 students; Big-Brother-and-Big-Sister Scheme; teacher training and workshops on catering for students with special educational needs (SEN). Ever since 2010, we have held two to three weeks of S.1 Orientation Programmes for S.1 students to help them adapt to their new school life by concerted efforts of different committees. In 2020-21, S1 Orientation Weeks were organized for students. It is hoped that students can better prepare themselves for their secondary education. Besides, the great support given by the educational psychologist (20 visits or more a year with collaboration and support given to teachers and parents by the school sponsoring body, funded by the EDB), the two school social workers (by Hong Kong Children and Youth Services, funded by the EDB), a part-time counselling worker and an additional Teaching Assistant (funded by the Learning Support Grant) meets the needs of SEN students and at the same time provides pastoral care for those students who are in need. In a word, our school team members endeavour to realize our potential and develop a deepening sense of care for the needy students and their family.

It is not easy for students to face sudden changes and new challenge in the year 2020-2021. It is crucial that students should equip with positive attitude towards failure. The "Failure Week" aimed at building up positive power to failure was launched by Counselling Committee & Moral & Civil Education Committee. The programme included 3-days warm-up games to reframe the meaning of failure; life education lesson 'Failure is success, got it? (失敗乃成功,知有?)" for S1 – S3 students promoted the idea of the growth mindset; sharing by alumni about his path from failure to success and a

21-Day challenge which helped students building up good habit with positive attitude for all students. Students gave positive feedback to the programme and around 200 students participate the challenge and had deep self-reflection.

#### **B.** Inclusive Education

Student Support Team for SEN (SST) has been formed since 2008 to cater for students with special educational needs. Each year identification work starts with S.1 registration in which parents are invited on a voluntary basis to submit information regarding their children with special educational needs. Follow-up work is then provided for both newcomers as well as existing SEN students. Through Special Education Management Information System (SEMIS), the school applies for the Learning Support Grant (LSG) for Secondary School. The LSG is used for providing SEN students with appropriate supportive measures and services.

Various supportive strategies and measures have been adopted for SEN students, with a referral system set up for all teaching staff for any suspected cases which will then be referred to the educational psychologist for consultation and /or assessment. Apart from referrals, various school-based supportive measures which include regularly having contacts with students' parents, arranging education programmes or accommodation for each SEN student and teachers attending case conferences. Teachers are also advised to adjust the classroom management techniques, teaching strategies, assignments and adjustments in examinations are given to the students concerned in order to cater for individual needs. Other support such as speech therapy training for individual students, study groups and social skills groups have been provided for students with the corresponding needs as well.

#### C. Character building via Spiritual, Moral and Civic Education Development

For students' character building, Christian value is instilled in students by offering Life Education lessons, Biblical Knowledge lessons, fellowship programmes, services and religious activities throughout the year as well as Gospel Week held in mid October every year. The theme in 2020-21 was 'An Unexpected Life' (生命不似預期). Christian students and teachers give their personal witness and share their faith via hymn singing sessions while sharing sessions are also regularly arranged in the morning assemblies. About 80 students attend the fellowship programmes during lunch hour on Tuesdays. Praise the Lord and thanks should go to both parish workers and teachers who make the very good church-school collaboration possible between the church and school.

To foster students' positive moral value and civic awareness, the promotion of environmental protection and use fewer bottles are advocated. Along with the various school-based teaching kits on moral issues, it is hoped that students' sense of civic awareness can be developed. Besides, the inter-class competitions on cleaning, discipline and bulletin board design also helped to foster our students a sense of responsibility, to develop their class spirit and sense of ownership in school.

#### D. Students' Potential and Leadership Development

In recognizing students' potential, various ambassador award schemes were devised. The 'Student All-round Award Scheme' encouraged students to have wholesome and balanced development. While the 'Student of the Class Scheme' recognized students' perseverance, courtesy and caring spirit apart from their very good performance in learning. The various 'Outstanding Student Awards' aimed at having students' potential recognized and their achievements honoured. The 'Super Class' award for each level was given to the super class which had got outstanding achievements in all respects. Besides, the 'Students' Perseverance Award Scheme' and 'Outstanding Leadership Award Scheme', which was initiated and supported by the Alumni Association in 2017-18, encouraged students to work with perseverance and develop their potential in various respects. For S.6 students, there were the awards of 'Student of the Year' and 'Outstanding Service Award', with the former granted to S.6 student who had outstanding performance in services provided to school or the community whereas the latter granted to the student who had reasonably good academic results and provided outstanding services to school or the community. It is our hope that students can stretch their potential and develop their leadership to become leaders of tomorrow with the provision of different awards for students of various levels.

#### E. Career development

To facilitate individual students to do their planning, various introductory exercises of the world of work were provided for students, as well as activities that could promote self-understanding of their personalities, skills, academic interests and career aspirations. Further exploration of students' interest in work was arranged with the aids of Holland Code (RIASEC) Test and Career Interest Test. Students were guided in interpreting

assessment outcomes, supported in formulating their career goals and educational planning, and developing career management skills that prepare them as lifelong learners in society. Because of the half-day school arrangement under the pandemic, many career guidance programmes can only be arranged online, while a hospitality job shadowing summer camp was held for senior form students for authentic learning. S6 Parents' Night was held on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2021 evening to provide information to parents and prepare students before the release of HKDSE results on 21<sup>st</sup> Jul 2021.

An online trade fair was held for the JA Company Programme in 2020-21 because of the pandemic. We participated in this entrepreneurial learning experience with local and international schools in Hong Kong. This learning experience filled with our tenacious effort and persevering attitude towards work, which were worth being commemorated. It is anticipated that we can pass on the torch of knowledge in launching enterprises to the JA members in subsequent years.

#### F. Community and global outreaching

Through participating in 'iCare 11' Voluntary Service Campaign and Other Learning Experiences activities organized by the Moral and Civic Education Committee and the Extra Curricular Activities Committee, it provides some chances for students to take part in various community services and meaningful voluntary activities. Due to the COVID-19 in all over the world, most of the activities were held in school such as the online talks or workshop related to understanding and caring some people in need such as ADHD, the disables and so on. Some outdoor activities, for example, visiting the elderly home, serving the homeless or physically impaired and low-income groups will be arranged in the coming school year. It is hoped that different types of Voluntary Service and experiential voluntary activates can be arranged in 2021-22 so as to enrich students' exposure and insights.

#### G. Home-School and Alumni Co-operation

A group of dedicated volunteers and committee members of the Parent-Teacher Association Committee (PTAC) have been assisting school in various school and off-campus activities. They offered assistance in organizing seminars, interest groups and running sharing sessions for parents. They also made donations to the students and their family who have financial needs, and presented awards to the students who did well in

their attendance and handing in assignments. Their contributions did bring a closer tie between the school and family, thus building up students' sense of belonging to school. Besides, the Alumni Association gave their support to school in many ways. Some alumni shared with students their study skills or how to develop the power of leadership. The talk delivered by alumni held on 27th November 2019 was well received by both junior-level and senior-level students.


#### V. STUDENT PERFORMANCE

#### A. HKDSE Examination Results

2020-21 school year has been a year of challenge. Our students have done well in the 2021 HKDSE. The overall passing rate reached 95.4% (99.1% in English Language, 98.1% in Mathematics, 97.2% in Chinese Language, 95.3% in Liberal Studies. 100% in Chinese History, DAT, ICT, M2and VA, 96.3% in Geography, 90.5% in Biology, 87.5% in BAFS and Chemistry, 85.2% in Physics, 84.8% in Economics. The average subject Level 4 or above rate was 26.6%. There were in total 116 counts of Level 5 or above. The most outstanding student, 6A Cheung Ka Chun attained Level 5\* in 5 subjects. JUPAS statistics told us that 52% of our students obtained a JUPAS offer, (33.7% degree offer and 18.3% sub-degree offer). Students' results in 2021 have shown their perseverance.


